awator implies any functionality for procurement and cashing up of trade, using standard service specifications (specs) which describe and value trade achievements and deliveries.

Any contract between purchaser and contractor is based on these specs.

These contracts contain all further conditions (e.g. period of validity) needed for a later procurement.

Referring to these contracts the purchaser creates one or several orders, containing a brief description, the term of the action to be performed and some specifications about the contractor and the location.

These contracts are sent to the contractor electronically via data media or dial-up connections. Having executed one or all achievements and deliveries the contractor creates allowances with a detailed compilation of all positions needed for accounting and referring to the specs specified in the contract.

Measurements provide a unique and audit-secure documentation of the ascertainment of quantities, working hours etc. The allowances are likewise resent to the purchaser electronically.
